Methodology Statement

These polls were conducted in Florida's 4th, 7th, 13th, and 15th Congressional Districts from July 5-7. Each poll was taken of N=400 likely Republican primary voters. Respondents were contacted via a combination of cell phones and landlines using IVR and text-to-web, and the margin-of-error is ±4.89%.

Debate Invitees

To qualify for the debates, the candidate must have polled at 5% or greater in the RPOF poll of each respective primary race or raised and publicly reported at least \$100,000 in monetary contributions by July 13, 2022.

Below is the table of qualified candidates that we tested in the brushfire surveys. Candidates above the red line received at least 5% in the brush fire and will qualify under the polling criteria. Candidates that are highlighted met the qualification of raising at least \$100k by July 13, even though they did not receive 5% or greater in the brushfire survey.
